Summary of Amendment # A01701 to Senate Bill 367

Amendment Sponsor: D. White

- Adds definitions:
 - “State system land.” Land owned by the State System of Higher Education or controlled by the State System of Higher Education pursuant to a memorandum of understanding approved by the Department of General Services.
 - “System” The State System of Higher education.
- Provides DGS the authority to convey mineral rights with property that is conveyed.
- Adds a section for the development of mineral resources on State system land.
 - The system has the authority to make and execute contracts or leases in the name of the Commonwealth for the mining or removal of valuable mineral resources which may be found in or beneath State System land.
 - All payments or royalties derived from any lease entered into by the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education shall be deposited in the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund.
- No less than fifty percent of payments or royalties received by the department pursuant to a contract or lease under this act shall be deposited into the Environmental Stewardship Fund or the Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund. The remaining payments received by the department shall be deposited into the General Fund.
